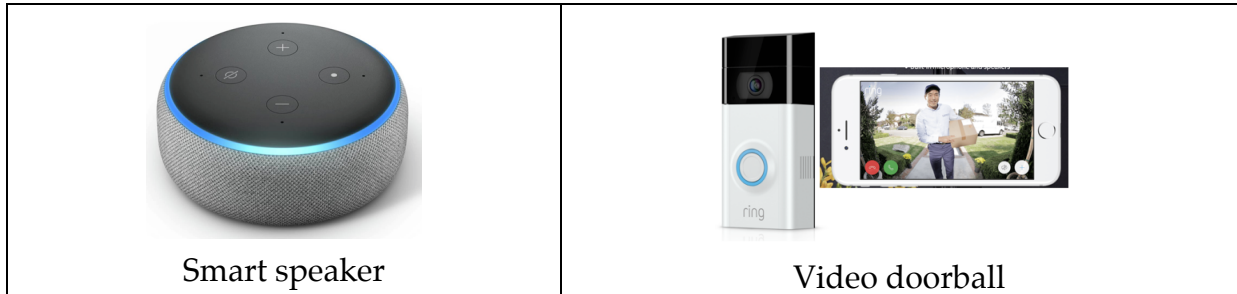

Smart speaker

Using voice control technology to make life easier for the elderly offers substantial assistance in allowing people to keep in touch even when the ability to use modern communication devices diminishes. This greatly enhances independence as people feel in touch even when they are not physically seeing family so often and assists with combatting loneliness. We have used the Amazon Echo to date and have set this up to enable users to do the following by voice control only:

- Make a telephone call
- Call for help without having to find or press a button
- Play a huge number of radio stations including all the common BBC and commercial stations
- Read stories
- Read the news or weather
- Tell you about / read anything that can be found on the Internet so for instance poems, books you have in a Kindle account and others, provide recipes, spell, play soothing sounds (or not so soothing), help you meditate, provide reminders and look up anything in Wikipedia
- Set timers
- Allow your nearest and dearest to 'drop in' on you audibly so you can speak to each other from either other Alexa devices or an Alexa app on a mobile phone
- If you have more than one act as an intercom
- Interact (with additional devices) to control lighting, heating and televisions.

Video doorbell

The Ring doorbell works with Alexa and can also allow family / others to see who is at an elderly person's front door from a mobile phone.
